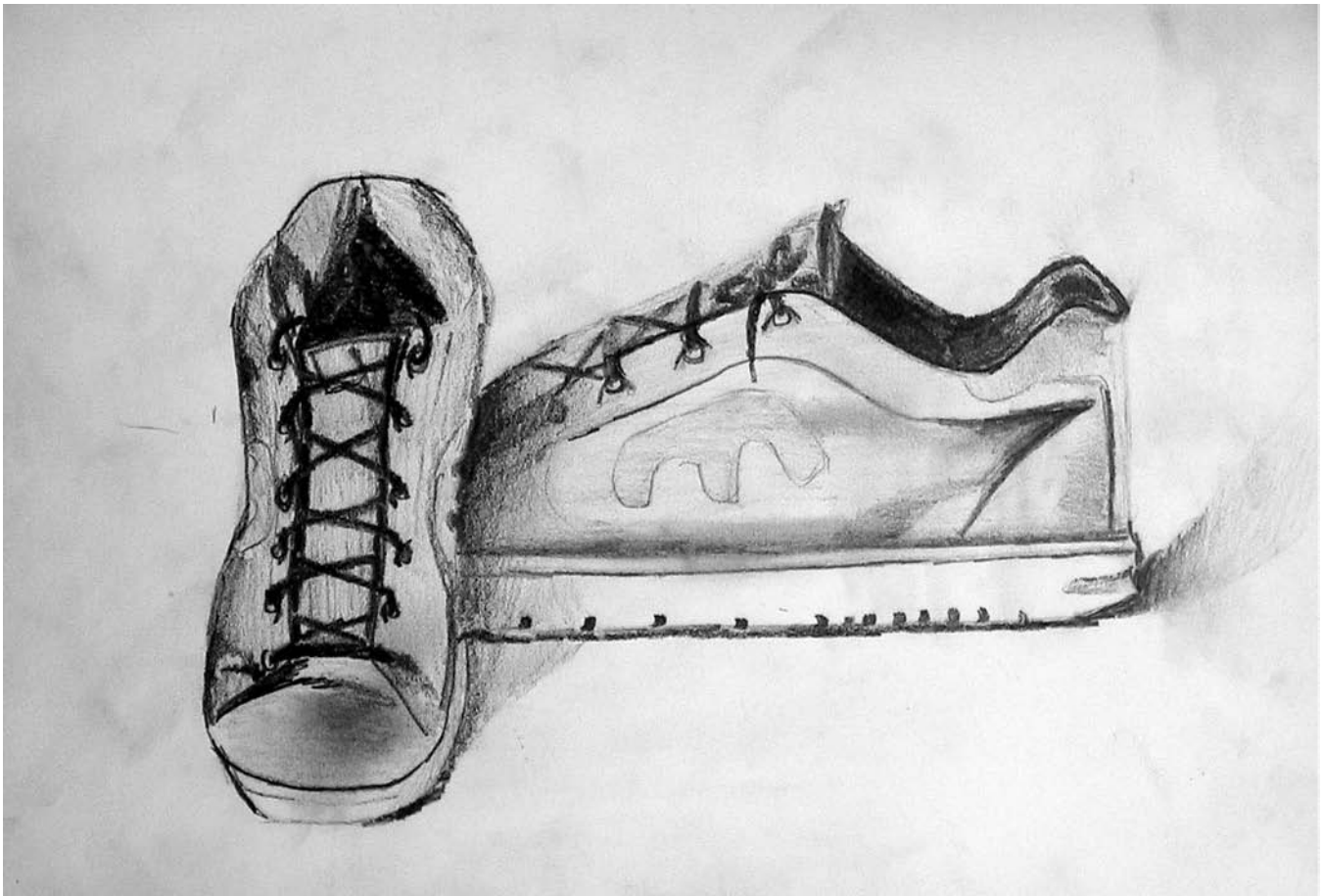


## SHOES AND FORESHORTENING

**Homework Assignment:** do a sketchbook drawing of a pair of shoes, one in profile and one facing towards you (foreshortened). Use a medium of your choice: pencil, charcoal, or conté crayon. Spend at least 2 hours on it.

**Strategies:** set-up your still life of shoes with a light source that angles down onto the subjects from the upper left or right. Think about the composition -- lightly pencil-in a sketch that captures the entire still life on the page and keeps at least a 1/2" border of white space. Use the technique of sighting with your pencil, to measure relative distances. Check your distances using the technique of triangulation. For a review of sighting with your pencil and triangulation, read pp. 63-67.
